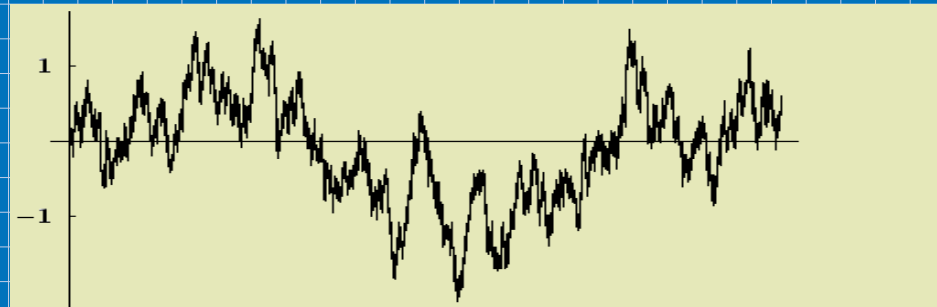

**Keith Ball (UC London):**

"The second law of probability: entropy growth in the central limit theorem"

The talk will explain how a geometric principle led to a new viewpoint of information-theoretic entropy and the solution of a 50 year old problem: whether there is an analogue of the second law of thermodynamics for the central limit theorem of probability.
